MAIDEN VOYAGES



With the major expansion of services and facilities in the last 12 months, Port Kembla has seen a number of vessels visit the port for the first time.

The completion of the major project to transform the port's Inner Harbour has resulted in a diversification of the ports trade base, to include motor vehicle imports and general cargo.

Just some of the vessels to make their Maiden Voyage in the recent months include:

- MV Tijuca arrived on Sunday the 3rd May to deliver a shipment of vehicles.
- MV Toreador visited on Friday the 19th June with a shipment of vehicles.
- MV Torino visited on Wednesday the 8th July also delivering vehicles.
- MV Sea of Harvest arrived on Thursday the 16th July to load coal.
- MV Silverstone Express visited on Saturday the 18th July to unload vehicles.

- MV Positive Passion arrived on Friday the 14th of August with a shipment of vehicles.
- MV Diamantgracht visited on Friday the 14th August to load copper concentrates.



OUTER HARBOUR UPDATE

The Environmental Assessment for the Outer Harbour Master Plan is nearly complete and is expected to be lodged with the Department of Planning in the coming weeks.

The Master Plan will guide development of the Outer Harbour well into the future.

The assessment has included detailed studies in relation to road and rail movements, aquatic ecology, water and sediment quality, noise, hydrodynamics, air quality, cultural heritage as well as management plans for green and golden bell frogs and waste.

The Environmental Assessment process will be an opportunity for the community to have their say on the Master Plan.

YOUNG ACHIEVERS AUSTRALIA

Port Kembla Port Corporation has again been actively involved in supporting this year's Young Achievement Australia 'Business Skills Program'.

The Business Skills Program is Young Achievement Australia's

primary enterprise education program. It brings together senior secondary and tertiary students with advisers from business and industry. The program provides an authentic learning environment for a team of young people to build their skills, knowledge and experience by putting their ideas into action to establish, plan and operate a self directed business.

Under the program, fifteen Year 11 students from local schools including Smith's Hill High School, Keira High School and the Illawarra Christian School, have set up an enterprise known as "Fiyaworks".

Fiyaworks is working to design, produce, market and sell a range of T-shirts incorporating new and dynamic designs which cannot be found anywhere else. PKPC's Sustainability Officer, Trevor Brown has been working with the group, attending board meetings to oversee the running of the enterprise and provide valuable business advice.

"The business program assists the students the in developing leadership and teamwork skills" said Mr Brown.

"Acting as an advisor to the group gives me opportunity to share my own unique expertise and career journey with participants." It also allows me to advise the students of the potential career opportunities that the port provides".
